Assistant Chaplain for Crete

We are seeking a priest with flair and energy to develop the spiritual life and increase the numbers of the congregation at St. Thomas, Crete. There are many opportunities for outreach, especially in summer months. Experience and resilience will be needed as well as the ability to be self-motivated, though there will be support from the Senior Chaplain in Athens, and from two more local priests with PTO, and the local Church Council.

We will expect the Assistant Chaplain to work Sundays and the equivalent of two days.

The package will include housing, a car, reasonable expenses, Greek state health care (enhanced), state pension contributions (which count towards a UK state pension), and 5000 euros net per year. There is no contribution to the Church of England Pension Fund.

The successful applicant will be employed in Greece and will have to obtain a Greek residence and work permit. He/she will also become subject to Greek income tax.
