DIOCESAN PRAYER DIARY

This diary has been compiled to help us pray together for one another and our common concerns. As well as the printed version, it is available on the diocesan website www.europe.anglican.org, both for downloading and for viewing. The latter is updated as new appointments and other changes are announced.

With a new Prayer Diary editor, a new layout. Each chaplaincy, with the communities it serves, is remembered in prayer once a quarter, according to the following weekly pattern:

- **Archdeaconry of France:** Tuesday, Saturday
- **Archdeaconry of Gibraltar:** Wednesday, Saturday

On Sundays, we pray for subjects which affect all of us (e.g. reconciliation, on Remembrance Sunday), or which have local applications for most of us (e.g. the local cathedral or cathedrals). This will include Diocesan Staff, Churches in Communion and Ecumenical Partners. Some chaplains might like to include regular prayers for the other chaplaincies in their deanery.

SUNDAY INTERCESSIONS should, by tradition, include prayer for Bishop Robert and the local Head of State by name. In addition, prayers may also include Bishop David (the Suffragan Bishop) and, among the heads of other states, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and the leaders of other countries represented in the congregation.
